ELIGIBILITY

- Be a **CURRENT STUDENT IN COLLEGE** with a GPA of 3.0 or above
- Show leadership potential and have past community service
- Be a student from an under-represented group (male or female)
- Demonstrate financial need

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The following items must be submitted to constitute a completed application:

- An application that includes a personal essay answering a prescribed question in no more than 500 words
- Two (2) unopened letters of recommendation from professors, community or religious leaders
- An official transcript from the most recently completed semester of college
- Proof that you are enrolled in the current semester (e.g. a paid bill)
- Proof of family income (acceptable documents include copies of the applicant's and parent/guardian(s) 2019 W-2 statement(s) or tax return)

All students who receive scholarship funds must sign a verification form indicating that the funds will be used only for higher education expenses e.g. tuition, room and board, or other related expenses.
